BIBLE WORDS...

Call or Calling. The word appears more than 800 times in the Bible and most often is a gracious invitation by God for a person to join Him in His Holy work. God uses the word to summon someone to Himself (Matthew 20:8), be redeemed (Romans 8:30), be entrusted with the preaching of the Gospel (Acts 16:10). It sometimes has adjectives so we get the point - like "His calling" in Ephesians 1:18, or a "high calling" in Philippians 3:14, or "holy calling" in 2 Timothy 1:9, or "YOUR calling" in 2 Thessalonians 1:11. All in all God wants to make sure we all understand we are called. The very nature of our calling and specific duties or blessings of our calling may be unique, but we are all called. Perhaps the most important verse to communicate this is found in 1 John 3:1 where he writes, "See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are!"
